County Executive Nicholas J. Pirro has announced that the Sensis Corporation will begin a major, multiphase expansion project in the Collamer Business Park in the Town of Dewitt. The first phase of this project will include a 69,000 square foot research and development facility with a total initial cost of \$12,600,000. Over the next three years, the company plans to add 250 employees to the existing workforce of 350. The Sensis Corporation is a developer and manufacturer of air-traffic, radar and surveillance equipment.

“The Sensis Corporation is exactly the type of company we need to support in Onondaga County,” said County Executive Pirro. “The scale of the investment, the Company’s long term plan for growth, and the technology basis of its products mean the Company will be an important part of the economic foundation of the County. We are pleased to have the opportunity to help it expand in Onondaga County,” he said. The County Industrial Development Agency will begin its review of the project at the August meeting. The County Zone Administrative Board will also review the project as part of a pending zone boundary revision. A portion of the site is in the Empire Zone and changes may be considered to accommodate the project.

The Sensis Corporation was started in 1985 by Jud Gostin. In order to achieve the growth the company has projected, it must be able to attract and retain engineering talent, particularly in software development. The new project and the future campus plan for facilities are intended to support the recruiting and retention processes.
